SERVICES INFORMATION

- Students at HMS, HSPH, HSDM, DMS, GSAS, HBS, and undergraduates at Harvard College, as well as Harvard University Officers and Staff, need only swipe their University ID card to ride the bus for free.
- Cambridge-based Harvard graduate students must either purchase tickets at the M2 ticket offices or add value to their Crimson Cash account (which is accessed by their Harvard ID) at the Crimson Cash website www.cash.harvard.edu. \$2.00 per ride will be deducted from your Crimson Cash account.
- Riders who are not affiliated with the University must also purchase tickets, or Crimson Cash Cards.
- No cash fares accepted.
- Drivers are allowed to pick up and discharge passengers at designated stops only.
- The bus stops on the opposite side of the traffic island at Vanderbilt Hall to pick up passengers (except Coolidge Corner route which picks up passengers on the same side as Vanderbilt Hall).
- Scheduled departure times in Cambridge are from Lamont Library gate on Quincy Street. The bus will pass Johnston Gate and pick up passengers BEFORE the scheduled departure time.
- Starting with the 6:00 pm trip from Cambridge and the 6:30 pm from Vanderbilt Hall, the bus will stop at any MBTA stop upon flag or request, except between Trowbridge Street and Lamont Library Gate.
- All trips marked via Coolidge Corner will stop at any MBTA stop upon flag or request only, except on Commonwealth Avenue and also between Trowbridge Street and Lamont Library Gate.
- Hot liquids are not allowed on the bus.
- No smoking on the bus.
- Passengers must use headphones with their radios, tape players or portable CD players.
- Running time is about 25 minutes.
- All trips may be delayed by traffic and/or inclement weather.
- Animals are not allowed on the bus, unless required by individuals with disabilities.
- Bicycles must be stored on the bike racks on the outside front of the bus.



ALTERNATE ROUTING

Alternate routes do not serve Simmons or The Museum School.

*** Via Coolidge Corner**
Bus goes up Longwood Avenue, turns onto Harvard Street, then onto Cambridge Street, crosses over the River Street Bridge, drives up to Brookline Street to Mass. Avenue, and continues through Central Square to Harvard Square. These trips will not stop at Mass. Avenue, Commonwealth Avenue, Beacon Street, or MIT. Request stops at all MBTA bus stops.

*** Express Service**
Bus makes three flag/request stops between Harvard Square and Vanderbilt Hall: (1) at the Bread & Circus on Putnam Ave., (2) on the corner of Granite St. and Brookline St., and (3) at Fenway Station MBTA stop.

Drivers are allowed to pick up and discharge passengers only at designated stops!
